Re: Vaccine Update: Vaxelis (DTaP-IPV-Hib-HepB)

Effective July 13, 2021, the Iowa VFC Program will allow providers to begin ordering Vaxelis vaccine.

Vaxelis (DTaP-IPV-Hib-HepB) is a combination vaccine approved for use in children 6 weeks through 4 years of age (prior to the 5<sup>th</sup> birthday) and is indicated for the 3 dose primary vaccination series in infants at ages 2, 4, and 6 months. The recommended minimum age for the third dose of Vaxelis is 24 weeks, the minimum age for completion of the HepB vaccine series. It should not be used for children less than 6 weeks of age or older than 4 years of age. It is not approved for the booster dose of DTaP (dose 4 or 5) or IPV (dose 4) or Hib (dose 4).

When placing an order for Vaxelis vaccine, please review the clinic's vaccine inventory to identify all other vaccines needed. VFC providers should continue to place vaccine orders consistent with their economic order quantity (monthly, bimonthly or quarterly) and monitor existing inventory to ensure VFC vaccine is not wasted or allowed to expire.
