

Introduction

Iowa Code 29.C.20A.5 requires the Iowa Department of Human Services (DHS) to report annually by January 1 of each year, to the Legislative Fiscal Committee and the Government Oversight Committee concerning the activities of the Iowa Individual Assistance Grant Program (IIAGP) for the previous fiscal year.

State Fiscal Year 2014

For State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2014 the IIAGP was used for one disaster event that occurred in the month of June that impacted thirty-eight counties.

In June 2014 major storms, heavy flooding and powerful winds were experienced across a number of Iowa counties. At the request of individual County Emergency Management coordinators, Governor Branstad declared an Individual Assistance Disaster Emergency designating the following thirty-eight counties:

The Department of Human Services initially requested and received approval from the Executive Council of Iowa to expend up to \$400,000 for the disaster.

As additional counties were added, The Department of Human Services requested, and the Executive Council of Iowa approved, an additional \$950,000 in funding for the disaster.

The Department of Human Services is currently contracted with the Iowa Community Action Association to administer the IIAGP services statewide. The total number of unduplicated families served during SFY '14 was 278 with assistance expenditures to date of \$1,217,206.98.
