

I did not observe overflowing garbage cans or garbage on the floor. I did not note a terrible smell in the center. Ms. Heuer states when the rabbit cages need cleaned there can be a slight smell. I would also recommend cleaning rabbit cages more than once each week. Staff members had positive interaction with the children. I did not observe staff ignoring children. Staff members were engaged in activities with the children. In the Sea Creature room I noted that staff members needed to have more control over the children as the room was chaotic. I did not observe children running around rooms in their jackets or without shoes. There were laundry baskets in the room, but they had lids and children did not have access to them. There are color markings on the walls from the children. I did not observe anything sticky or unsafe. The children are fed breakfast, lunch and a morning and afternoon snack.

Special Notes and Action Required:

109.11(3)a(1). Center and premises are sanitary, safe and hazard free. NOT VIOLATED. As noted above there were areas that needed additional cleaning, but I did not observe anything that I would consider a safety or health hazard. I would recommend going through all of the rooms and thoroughly cleaning items. It is reported that staff members clean rooms daily, but perhaps they are not doing so properly. Go over the cleaning procedures with staff and stress the importance of cleaning items thoroughly.
