



children first entered the outdoor playground, two children went to the fence area that runs parallel to Boyson Road. Staff was overheard reminding the children of the playground rules including not climbing on the fence. Staff was then observed redirecting the children by getting out the outdoor building blocks and encouraging them to play. Later during the outdoor play, a man walking a dog adjacent to the playground fence was observed. Children were observed moving towards the fence attempting to put their hands and feet through the fence. Staff was diligent in requesting the children not talk with strangers accessing the sidewalk or attempt to pet strange animals.

109.10(10). Written incident reports are being completed as required by code. THERE IS NOT ENOUGH INFORMATION TO STATE THIS RULE WAS AND/OR IS VIOLATED. Ms. Klett reported incident reports are being done. Ms. Klett talked about how one parent recently appeared confused with getting an incident report for a scratch his/her child suffered. Ms. Klett explained incident reports are done anytime there is an injury regardless of severity, a behavioral concern, biting, or anything out of the ordinary.

Ms. Jakoubek reported there have been no more injuries or incident at the center than usual. Ms. Jakoubek denied that anyone reported the above concerns to her prior to her scheduled vacation.

**Special Notes and Action Required:**

Licensing strongly recommends when the playground fence needs to be replaced, a privacy fence be installed.
