

The complaint was discussed with the director, Tracey. Licensing rules state children under the age of two must be kept separate from children over the age of two. However, a child 18 months and older can be moved up to a two year old room if developmentally ready, and the ratio of infants (1:4) must be maintained as well as the ratio for two year olds (1:6).

Tracey thought two year olds could be together with infants if the two ratios (1:4 and 1:6) were maintained. The rule was clarified and Tracey said she would make sure the two year olds came to the 3/4 year old room in the future.
