Special Notes and Action Required:

When staff were asked how many children were currently present in their rooms, they had to check their iPads first before giving me a number. The staff should always know off the top of their heads how many kids they have in their care and not rely on their iPad. This would indicate the staff are not doing random head counts throughout the day which means a child could leave their room and the staff would not realize this since they don't do head counts.
