



It is noted that per licensing, blankets can be used in the cribs so long as the blanket is large enough that it can be firmly tucked under the crib mattress and no higher than waist high on the infants. The blanket should also be of lighter material. Best practice is that no blankets be used in the cribs and this is what the center practices.

While the center was technically in non-compliance in regards to blankets being used in a manner not described above and a child was in a bouncy seat while in the crib, the center director and her supervisors were already aware of the situation and handled the situation appropriately in regards to the staff member responsible. Therefore, no further action is being taken in regards to this manner.

**Special Notes and Action Required:**

The new on-site supervisor of the center as of 6/2013 is Linzie Manzer. She meets the qualifications for the position.

This consultant followed up with the director regarding playground safety. The director stated another all staff meeting would be held later in the day to cover playground safety again. At the current time, due to the cold and snow covered playground, the playground area hasn't been used.
