



Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) Certification Process

Successful bidders of the Agency's CCBHC Request for Proposal (RFP) will participate in the Agency's certification process. Certified clinics will be eligible to be reimbursed by Medicaid as a CCBHC for a 2 year period beginning no later than July 1, 2017, dependent on SAMHSA awarding Iowa a CCBHC Demonstration Grant. To be certified clinics must successfully complete each of the steps listed below by October 1, 2016.

1. Be a successful bidder of the CCBHC RFP MHDS 16-020 and be contracted with the Agency to provide CCBHC services.
2. Participate in the needs assessment completed by the Agency.
3. Submit for Agency approval a staffing and training plan guided by the Agency's needs assessment and initial staffing plan.
4. Submit for Agency approval a cost report following PPS-1 guidelines.
5. Be accredited as either a CMHC or MHSP; and be licensed as an Outpatient Substance Use Disorder Treatment Provider.
6. Participate in the Agency's certification review using the SAMHSA certification tool which may include a site visit and/or desk review.
7. Participate in Agency certification compliance reviews on a quarterly basis throughout the contract period.
