## MISSOURI

- Substance Use Disorder (Customer Information Management, Outcomes, and Reporting System-CIMOR)
  - Who Gathers Data: Providers
  - What: Information is gathered in the following general categories:
    - Demographics
    - Episode of care (Commitments, etc.)
    - Diagnostic information
    - Discharge and follow up information
  - How data is collected: Providers collect data from Consumer at admission, at program level changes, and at discharge.
  - Who is it gathered about:
  - Who uses the data:
- Developmental Disabilities (Customer Information Management, Outcomes, and Reporting System-CIMOR)
  - Who Gathers Data: Providers who contract with the Department of Mental Health
  - What: Information is gathered in the following general categories:
    - Demographics
    - Benefits and eligibility
    - Diagnosis Information
    - Information on Episodes of Care
    - Date of last Individual Habilitation Plan
  - How data is collected:
  - Who is it gathered about:
  - Who uses the data: Used in Division, Regional, and Provider quality enhancement plans.

## NEBRASKA

- Mental Health & Substance Use Disorder
  - Who Gathers Data: Providers enter information on the Magellan website.
  - What: Information is gathered in the following general categories:
    - Demographics, SES indicators
    - Admission information (level of care)
    - Service information
    - Discharge information
  - How data is collected: Data is managed and reported to the NE Department of Health and Human Services by Magellan.
  - Who is it gathered about: All consumers who meet eligibility requirements and receive services through the regional Behavioral Health System & State Medicaid program are required. Consumers receiving services funded by Regional Behavioral Health Authorities or private/self-pay may be registered.
  - Who uses the data: Providers can access monthly reports online. Data also used in Departmental annual reports.

## WASHINGTON

- Developmental Disabilities (Comprehensive Assessment, Reporting, and Evaluation System-CARE)
  - Who Gathers Data: Case managers
  - What: Information is gathered in the following general categories:
    - Demographics
    - Assessment information (Using the Supports Intensity Scale & Mini Assessment tool)
    - Service eligibility information
    - Assessment history
  - How data is collected: Information entered into an electronic case management system. Algorithms calculate services based on the Assessment portion. Individuals are reassessed on an annual basis or when significant changes in their situation happen.
  - Who is it gathered about: Individuals who receive DDD services, individuals receiving care through and HCBS waiver, individuals requesting an assessment.
  - Who uses the data: Department of Developmental Disabilities uses data in annual reports.

\*\* Washington also collects and reports National Core Indicators data in the national NCI data collection system

- Substance Use Disorder (Treatment and Assessment Reports Generation Tool-TARGET Data Management System)
  - Who Gathers Data: Providers
  - What: Information is gathered in the following general categories:
    - Demographics
    - Funding information
    - Assessments and admissions
    - Discharge information
    - Health information
    - Substance use/treatment information
  - How data is collected: Registered agencies enter information into TARGET system. System is managed by the Division of Behavioral Health and Recovery.
  - Who is it gathered about: Each individual receiving publically funded chemical dependency treatment in Washington State.
  - Who uses the data: Used by program and agency administrators and academic researchers to assist in their planning and studies.

## KANSAS

- Mental Health (Automated Information Management System-AIMS)
  - Who Gathers Data: Community Mental Health Centers Established as Regions
  - What: Information is gathered in the following general categories:
    - Demographics
    - Service encounter history/screening data
    - Client status-information on co-occurring disorders and hospitalization, contact with law enforcement etc.
    - Discharge information
  - How data is collected: From case managers. Entered after every encounter, demographic information is updated annually.
  - Who is it gathered about: Adults with SPMI and Children with and SED enrolled in services. Also collected for individuals who will potentially receive services.

- Who uses the data: Used for federal and state quality improvement reports and monitoring of CMHC's contracts. Also used by the Association of Community Mental Health Centers for legislative reporting and lobbying.
- Unique Identifier: 11 digits, made up of a combination of data.
- Developmental Disabilities (Basic Assessment and Services Information System-BASIS)
  - Who Gathers Data: Community Developmental Disability Organizations established as Regions. Data can be updated at any time (unless noted) and is submitted on a weekly basis to a central server.
  - What: Information is gathered in the following general categories:
    - Demographics
    - Assessment information (Updated annually)
    - Service information
    - Information about the service system
    - Use of psychotropic medication and psychotropic PRN medication (Updated every 6 months)
  - How data is collected: Collected by case managers as individuals apply for or enter service.
  - Who is it gathered about: All persons receiving services and those waiting and willing to accept services. Primarily those on the HCBS DD waiver.
  - Who uses the data: Division of Health Care Policy creates a monthly summary. Also used for statewide verification reports.
- Substance Use Disorder
  - Who Gathers Data: Providers
  - What: Information is gathered in the following general categories:
    - Demographics
    - Admission treatment episode data
    - Clinical tracking data
    - Discharge data
    - Outcomes data (social connectedness, abstinence, employment/education, housing etc.)
  - How data is collected: Providers send to the SUD Managed Care Provider
  - Who is it gathered about: All persons receiving SUD treatment
  - Who uses the data: The state uses this data to monitor performance based contracts. Data is also used for reporting to CMS
