For children under Section 1902 (a) (10) (i) (VII) and 1902(I)(1)(D) of the Act (children who were born after July 1, 1979, and have attained age 6 but have not attained age 19), the income eligibility level is 100 percent of the Federal poverty level (as revised annually in the Federal Register) for the size family involved.

2. Children Between Ages 6 and 19

Effective July 1, 1991, children between ages 6 and 19 with family incomes at or below 100% of the Federal poverty level became a mandatory group under P.L. 101-508, Section 4601. (See item A.4. of this supplement.)

For children between ages 6 and 19 eligible under Section 1902(l)(1)(D) as amended by P.L. 105-32, section 4731(b), the income eligibility level is 133% of the Federal poverty level (as revised annually in the Federal Register) for the size family involved.

If an individual receives a title II benefit, any amount attributable to the most recent increase in the monthly insurance benefit as a result of a title II COLA is not counted as income during a "transitional period" beginning with January, when the title II benefit for December is received, and ending with the last day of the month following the month of publication of the revised annual Federal poverty level.

For individuals with title II income, the revised poverty levels are not effective until the first day of the month following the end of the transition period.

For individuals not receiving title II income, the revised poverty levels are effective no later than the beginning of the month following the date of publication.

For persons described under Section 1905(p)(3)(A)(ii) of the Act, the income eligibility exceeds 100% of the Federal poverty level but is less than 110 percent in 1993 and 1994, and 120 percent in 1995 and years thereafter (as revised annually in the Federal Register) for the size family involved.
