<b>Provider Name</b>	<b>Area to be served</b>	<b>Appointment availability hours</b>	<b>Comments</b>
<b>Community Memorial Hospital (Alegent)</b>	Harrison County	144	ARNP with Psychiatric certification will use telehealth from her outpatient office to see children (and families) in a dedicated room at the school -- care coordination provided by school nurse
<b>Backbone Area Counseling Center</b>	Delaware County	96	One psychiatrist out of Cedar Rapids -- increased availability due to elimination of drive time
<b>Bridgeway</b>	Southeast Iowa -- Lee and Des Moines counties	192	Main site psychiatrist to see consumers at satellite site through telehealth. Eliminates transportation issues for consumers.
<b>Genesis Development</b>	Dallas County	192	Genesis Development worked in collaboration with Dallas County Community Services to develop this project -- Dr. Fialkov has an office in West Des Moines from which psychiatric services will originate
<b>Mental Health Center of North Iowa (and New Directions)</b>	Cerro Gordo, Floyd, and Winnebago counties	192	PA from New Directions (who will be receiving consultation services through the University project) providing services -- a great example of sharing resources -- the Center is expecting 2 new psychiatrists sometime around July 1st that will also be able to use telehealth with this in place
<b>Plains Area Mental Health Center</b>	Northwest Iowa -- Sioux, Plymouth, Buena Vista, and Ida counties	600	Very well written proposal -- Dr. Dean's office is also involved in the West Iowa CMHC project -- will only need one site worth of equipment -- another example of sharing resources that would otherwise be impossible

<b>Richmond Center</b>	Central and North Central Iowa -- Story, Carroll, and Webster counties	144	This project would serve both mental health and substance abuse clients -- ARNP will use telehealth to see consumers in Carroll and psychiatrist will use telehealth from Arizona to both Richmond Center sites (Ames and Carroll) and the CFR office in Fort Dodge. The Ames site is funded for equipment and technical assistance through the University project, through which the Ames office will receive some psychiatric services as well.
<b>West Iowa Community Mental Health Center</b>	Crawford County	96	Dean and Associates are also part of Plains Area project -- see notes. This project will allow Dr. Dean to provide psychiatric services to consumers at West Iowa Community Mental Health Center in Denison -- small project that is very manageable
<b>Youth and Shelter Services</b>	Story and Boone counties	192	Youth substance abuse -- agreement would include stipulation that they get a psychiatrist on board prior to implementation
