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1. Progress toward goals and objectives

- a. Goal #1: Provide mental health services in Crawford County schools
 - In FY13, the School Based Mental Health Specialist (therapist) position was continued.
 - The Specialist is based in the Denison Community Schools, however, the Specialist is available to all schools within the county as needed.
 - Since the beginning of the program in 2009 there has not been a civil mental health committal out of the school system (compared to 12 in 2009).
 - The position continues to be funding through DECAT, County Mental Health, Mental Health Center grant funds and the Denison Community Schools.
- b. Goal #2: To increase consumer awareness of Mental Health Issues, opportunities and advantages.
 - CPC provided community service and civic groups with education on ID/MH topics as well as funding and available services.
 - Crawford County offered scholarships for consumers to attend conferences and seminars throughout the year.
 - Crawford County continued to support West Iowa Community Mental Health Center by assisting with the maintenance of the Tele-Health program. This program has increased the availability of psychiatric services to consumers in Crawford County.

2. Documentation of stakeholder activity.

The Crawford County MH Advisory Board met six times throughout FY2013. The committee discussed service and funding issues, waiting list procedures, and were instrumental in the process of developing the Mental Health Management Plan and Strategic Action Plan. Meetings are open to the public and consumers and family members are welcome to attend.

6. Number, type and resolution of appeals:

No appeals were filed in Crawford County during the 2013 fiscal year. The appeals process is outlined in the MH Management Plan and also printed on the Notice of Decision and Funding Agreement given to the consumer, case manager and provider.

7. Quality Assurance Implementation, Findings, and Impact on Plan:

In fiscal year 2013 Crawford County utilized the results of the DHS Targeted Case Management. This survey indicated the persons receiving services through Crawford County were satisfied with the services provided by the county. Survey results from providers were also used in evaluation of services provided by the county.

Information obtained from various surveys, along with provider and consumer input was used in the restructuring of the County Mental Health Management Plan.

8. Waiting List:

Crawford County did not utilize a waiting for a FY2013. If a waiting list is enacted, the Mental Health Advisory Board acts as the wait list board and meets bimonthly. If a provider wishing to provide services to someone on the waiting list employs a member of the Board, they are exempt from making decisions on that case. Rules for the waiting list are published in the MH Management Plan.
