Tobacco-Free/Nicotine-Free Policy guidelines for use with Colleges

[College/ University] facilities and grounds, including vehicles owned or leased by [college/ university], are off limits for tobacco use, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, snuff, vape, pipes, snus, Electronic Smoking Devices (ESD), and nicotine products that are not Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved for tobacco cessation. This requirement extends to students, employees, and visitors. This policy applies at all times, including school-sponsored and non- school sponsored events. Persons failing to abide by this policy are required to extinguish their smoking material, dispose of the tobacco/vape/nicotine product or leave [college/university] premises immediately. It is the responsibility of the administration to enforce this policy.

Effective Date:

This policy statement is effective immediately upon the date of adoption.

To ensure the college has a strong tobacco-free/nicotine-free policy, <u>and to qualify for free window</u> clings and outdoor signage, the policy must explicitly include all of the following:

- ✓ Policy must extend to all types of tobacco, nicotine, vape, and ESD products (i.e. not only cigarettes; include all tobacco, ESDs and nicotine products not approved by the FDA for cessation.)
- ✓ Policy must extend to employees, students & visitors
- ✓ Policy must apply at all times, including school-sponsored & non- school-sponsored events
- Policy must extend to school vehicles
- ✓ Policy must extend to entire college property to receive outdoor signage
