




Based on the information obtained the complaint is not substantiated for a violation of licensing standards. The layout of the room does create a very limited area where a child could be in a position when sitting in a chair located between the refrigerator and a cabinet would not be directly observable by staff. However the staffing in the room with four adult present would make it unlikely that all staff members would be in the same limited area at the same time where direct line of site would be blocked

**Special Notes and Action Required:**

This report is not substantiated as a violation of licensing standards however recommendations are made that could address the concerns raised. As noted all areas identified for providing a child with a quiet area to go when upset with peers are located along the North end of the classroom. By moving the chair to an area of the Southwest corner this would eliminate the issue of an obstructed view location. It would also provide an option for children where children can go to create distance if programing is occurring or the peer they are having a problem with is located on the North end of the room.
