Complaint: The Department received a complaint concerning inadequate or improper supervision, dirty or unsanitary conditions.

Rule Basis: 110.5 (1,9)

Findings: Unsubstantiated

Resolution: Complaint check was completed on October 18, 2013. This worker did observe that the home was in need of a general cleaning due to a report of 4 cats and 2 dogs being cared for in the home. A CPW worker was involved and would address the concern of inadequate supervision. Corrective action was necessary, and a safety plan was initiated to protect the children.

On 11/14/13 the home and files were reinspected and had been corrective and now meets DHS standards. The CPW worker did not substantiate the claim of inadequate supervision.
