



had bumped the bookcase with the buggy or herself, but she must have because it fell backwards. Security cameras recorded the incident, and we were able to review the footage while at the center. It appeared this accident happened as it had been described to us.

These bookcases have been in this location for many years and there have never been any accidents. These bookcases are not anchored. Betty agreed to have the bookcases removed by the end of the day. A follow up visit was done and the bookcases had been removed. Permanent drywall walls have been constructed to enclose this staff work area


This was an unfortunate accident and the bookcases had been there for many years with no problems. However, the bookcases were unsafe and were a hazard as documented by the serious injuries a three year old child sustained when one of them fell on top of her. Therefore, this will be cited as a licensing violation.

While at the center, a visit was made to the youngest infant room. It was noted there were three babies sleeping in bouncy seats, and they all had blankets covering them. One baby had most of her face covered with the blanket. Babies should be sleeping in their cribs as this is considered a safe sleep environment. Babies should never have blankets covering their faces, especially their noses, as it is suspected this is a cause of SIDS deaths. Babies need to be breathing fresh air, and this doesn't happen if their mouths and noses are covered. The staff person Jeanne said the parents wanted the baby to fall asleep in the bouncy seat because of upper respiratory problems. She couldn't explain why the blanket was covering this baby's face, or why the other two weren't sleeping in their cribs. She later said the clean sheets hadn't been put on the cribs yet when the babies fell asleep. This also will be cited as a violation.
