The Partner Update is a monthly communications effort designed to share pertinent and important information that is specific to Iowa Medicaid's Accountable Care Organizations.

August 2015

Dashboard Refreshed August 20, 2015: The Dashboard tool reflects claims paid through June 30, 2015.

Current Statistics:

- There are a total of **663,881** Medicaid members analyzed in the dashboard which include percentages of the following:
 - Healthy and Non Users (**66.35%**)
 - Pregnancy/Delivery (**1.68%**)
 - Significant Acute (**8.52%**)
 - Minor Chronic (**7.15%**)
 - Moderate Chronics (**9.45%**)
 - Dominant Chronics (**6.38%**) – *Just over 42,000 individuals*
 - Malignancies and Catastrophic (**.47%**)
- Current VIS score by ACO:
 - Broadlawns (**43.3%**)
 - IowaHealth+ (**51%**)
 - Mercy ACO, LLC (**59.5%**)
 - Unity Point Health Partners (**60.3%**)
 - University of Iowa Health Alliance (**49.1%**)
 - All other PCPs – (**40.3%**)

Guiding Principle

The Iowa Medicaid Enterprise (IME) is responsible for supporting the healthcare delivery system's ability to analyze data, improve care, and track program measures by sharing reliable and consistent information in a timely way. The healthcare delivery system is responsible for analyzing and taking action on data by maximizing resources and implementing improved processes. Both the IME and the healthcare delivery system are ultimately responsible for improving population health and the delivery of healthcare as well as lowering the total cost of care (triple aim).

SIM: Thank you to those that participated in the State Innovation Models (SIM) Conference kick-off event at the Prairie Meadows Events Center in Altoona on August 18, 2015. The event brought together over 400 health care professionals with a focus on improving the health of Iowans through community leadership, partnerships, and implementing statewide strategies for the prevention of healthcare-associated infections, OB care, diabetes, and medication safety. Statewide Alert Notification (SWAN) System: Please ensure that your IT Contact(s) have scheduled your ADT Connection meeting with Andi Bryan (andrea.bryan@idph.iowa.gov) from the Iowa Department of Public Health. She has a Readiness Assessment and

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Attachment G of the IHIN Participation Agreement that needs to be complete prior to establishing an ADT connection and before an ACO can start receiving real-time alerts. Alerts are targeted to begin in October 2015.

Monthly Claims Sharing Process: The process to share claims with ACO providers on a monthly basis kicked off in October of 2014. Once your ACO has successfully accepted a test file, notify 3M to receive the three year file. From that point, regular claim updates will be sent each time the 3M Treo Dashboard is updated. If your ACO is interested in receiving claims, please email Marni Bussell at mbussel@dhs.state.ia.us to start the Claims Sharing Process.
