The Partner Update is a monthly communications effort designed to share pertinent and important information that is specific to Iowa Medicaid's Accountable Care Organizations.

Dashboard Refreshed July 15, 2015: The Dashboard tool reflects claims paid through April 30, 2015.

Current Statistics:

- **83 percent** of Medicaid Primary Care Providers qualify for the 2015 VIS Program
- There are a total of **654,523** Medicaid members analyzed in the dashboard which include percentages of the following:
 - Healthy and Non Users (**67.23%**)
 - Pregnancy/Delivery (**1.61%**)
 - Significant Acute (**8.36%**)
 - Minor Chronic (**6.95%**)
 - Moderate Chronics (**9.16%**)
 - Dominant Chronics (**6.24%**) – *Just under 41,000 individuals*
 - Malignancies and Catastrophic (**.45%**)
- Current VIS score by ACO:
 - Broadlawns (**46%**)
 - IowaHealth+ (**49.4%**)
 - Mercy ACO, LLC (**59.6%**)
 - Unity Point Health Partners (**63%**)
 - University of Iowa Health Alliance (**50.6%**)
 - All other PCPs – (**40.3%**)

Guiding Principle

The Iowa Medicaid Enterprise (IME) is responsible for supporting the healthcare delivery system's ability to analyze data, improve care, and track program measures by sharing reliable and consistent information in a timely way. The healthcare delivery system is responsible for analyzing and taking action on data by maximizing resources and implementing improved processes. Both the IME and the healthcare delivery system are ultimately responsible for improving population health and the delivery of healthcare as well as lowering the total cost of care (triple aim).

2014 4th Quarter's VIS Incentive Payment: The fourth quarter VIS incentive payment was paid the week of July 6th, 2015. For this quarter, a total of \$102,314 was paid to Patient



Managers and ACOs. The IME compiled and sent each ACO a report of Patient Managers and VIS bonus totals on July 17, 2014. The 1st quarter 2015 VIS payment is expected September 2015.

2015 Healthy Behavior Mid-Point Results:

Below are the results of our mid-year analysis of the Wellness Plan ACO Healthy Behavior measure. This is a reflection of the hard work and coordination efforts that each ACO partner has accomplished to-date. The IME will compile this report again in October of 2015.

NOTE: The denominator in this report reflects members enrolled in the program for at least six months during 2015, and any member with less than six months enrollment when they have completed at least one healthy behavior. The denominator in this report will likely NOT align with the number of members you see in your monthly ACO patient listing reports.

Care Management Gap Report (in the dashboard) Update: The Care Management Gap report has been updated to more closely align with other reports within the dashboard.



Health Risk Assessment (HRA) Updates: The IME will release a new shorter version of Assess My Health the week of July 20, 2015. On Wednesday July 22, at 12:00 PM (noon), 3M will conduct an overview of the changes. Please notify appropriate staff at the ACO level to attend this overview and have an opportunity to ask questions. We will be sending out detailed release notes in the coming days for those unable to attend the live event.

The new tool is shorter and provides less questions for members to answer which include updates to the Provider Summary report. The changes will NOT impact your process to administer or receive the HRA results. This meeting is a chance to walk through the updates and discuss with 3M. Monthly Claims Sharing Process: The process to share claims with ACO providers on a monthly basis kicked off in October of 2014. Once your ACO has successfully accepted a test file, notify 3M to receive the three year file. From that point, regular claim updates will be sent each time the 3M Treo Dashboard is updated.
