The Partner Update is a monthly communications effort designed to share pertinent and important information that is specific to Iowa Medicaid's Accountable Care Organizations.

May 2015

Dashboard Refreshed June 8, 2015: The Dashboard tool reflects claims paid through March 31, 2015.

Current Statistics:

- **83%** of Medicaid Primary Care Providers qualify for the 2015 VIS Program
 - **978** individual Primary Care Provider's (PCPs) analyzed for their Value Index Score (VIS) this month.
 - **807** PCPs have a VIS Target for 2015
- There are a total of **645,338** Medicaid members analyzed in the dashboard which include percentages of the following:
 - Health and Non Users (**67.44%**)
 - Pregnancy/Delivery (**1.59%**)
 - Significant Acute (**8.28%**)
 - Minor Chronic (**6.93%**)
 - Moderate Chronics (**9.07%**)
 - Dominant Chronics (**6.23%**) – *Just over 40,000 individuals*
 - Malignancies and Catastrophic (**.45%**)
- Current VIS score by ACO:
 - Broadlawns (**39.8%**)
 - IowaHealth+ (**49.4%**)
 - UnityPoint Health Partners (**60.1%**)
 - University of Iowa Health Alliance (**54.6%**)
 - All other PCPs – (**41.7%**)

Guiding Principle

The Iowa Medicaid Enterprise (IME) is responsible for supporting the healthcare delivery system's ability to analyze data, improve care, and track program measures by sharing reliable and consistent information in a timely way. The healthcare delivery system is responsible for analyzing and taking action on data by maximizing resources and implementing improved processes. Both the IME and the healthcare delivery system are ultimately responsible for improving population health and the delivery of healthcare as well as lowering the total cost of care (triple aim).

2014 3rd Quarter's VIS Incentive Payment: The third quarter VIS incentive payment was paid the last week of May, 2015. For this quarter, a total of \$126,368 was paid to Patient Managers and ACOs. The IME compiled and sent each ACO a report of Patient Managers and VIS bonus totals on May 22, 2014. The fourth quarter 2014 VIS payment is expected in mid to late July.

2014 Healthy Behavior Final Results: The final result of the 2014 Healthy Behavior measure has been compiled. The hard work of each ACO by communicating with members, tracking progress, and coordinating new processes for this program are evident in the results below. Using the adjustments made to the 2015 reporting year, each ACO successfully completed the measure. All have improved in the number complete in each category since the last report compiled in mid-December. Although the numerators (N) have all improved, there is a slight decrease in the denominator (D), due to Medicaid eligibility overlay that has removed members previously calculated with 6+ months.

ACO Patient Listing Report Updates: Several updates have been made to the ACO Patient Listing reports in May and June to help ACOs better track Healthy Behavior activities for members. Those updates have been documented in the ACO Communication Improvement Plan shared with each ACO. Please let us know if you have any questions regarding these improvements.



Health Risk Assessment (HRA) Updates: In late May, the IME updated the AssessMyHealth HRA with minor updates that include:

- Added a note to members that by completing this assessment, the member agrees to share this information with their primary care provider.
- Moved the Personal Information page (name, address, member ID, etc..) to the beginning of the survey
- Added a warning message if the member tries to abandon the survey before completely through the HRA.

Monthly Claims Sharing Process: The process to share claims with ACO providers on a monthly basis kicked off in October 2014. Once your ACO has successfully accepted a test file, notify 3M to receive the three year file. From that point, regular claim updates will be sent each time the 3M Treo Dashboard is updated. If your ACO is interested in receiving claims, please email Marni Bussell at mbussel@dhs.state.ia.us to start the Claims Sharing Process.

There have been minor updates to the claims data file layout in June of 2015. Please refer to the Document Library in the Dashboard homepage to retrieve the most up-to-date file layout specifications.
