Dashboard Refreshed November 13, 2015: The Dashboard tool reflects claims paid through August 31, 2015.

Current Statistics: There are a total of 690,710 Medicaid members analyzed in the dashboard which are comprised of the percentages below:

- Healthy and Non Users **(66.02%)**
- Pregnancy/Delivery **(1.77%)**
- Significant Acute **(8.36%)**
- Minor Chronic **(7.27%)**
- Moderate Chronic **(9.63%)**
- Dominant Chronic **(6.49%) – Just over 44,800 individuals!**
- Malignancies and Catastrophic **(.47%)**

Guiding Principle

The Iowa Medicaid Enterprise (IME) is responsible for supporting the healthcare delivery system’s ability to analyze data, improve care, and track program measures by sharing reliable and consistent information in a timely way. The healthcare delivery system is responsible for analyzing and taking action on data by maximizing resources and implementing improved processes. Both the IME and the healthcare delivery system are ultimately responsible for improving population health and the delivery of healthcare as well as lowering the total cost of care (triple aim).

CMMI Site Visit: The SIM leadership will be hosting a site visit by CMMI staff on December 16 and 17. We will be welcoming Leah Nash and Dr. Steven Cha from Washington D.C.

Statewide Alert Notification (SWAN) System: Broadlawns Medical Center and Genesis Health Systems are both live sending ADT messages to the SWAN system. Unity Point is validating ADT's and almost live. Additional ACO's are making significant progress toward "live" status.

Please ensure that your IT Contact(s) have scheduled your ADT Connection meeting with Andi Bryan (andrea.bryan@idph.iowa.gov) from the Iowa Department of Public Health. She has a Readiness Assessment and Attachment G of the IHIN Participation Agreement that needs to be complete prior to establishing an ADT connection and before an ACO can start receiving real-time alerts. Alerts are targeted to begin in November 2015.

SIM Website Design: The SIM website will be redesigned to reflect the collaborative work between IME, IDPH and IHC. Updates will be added regularly and the site will serve as a point of information for healthcare transformation and alignment related to the Iowa SIM initiatives. Healthy Behavior Report: The 2015 historical report related to the Healthy Behavior work is a compilation of 9 months of data and has been distributed to all Medicaid ACO's for discussion during their monthly meetings. A table depicting the ACO's results is found below:

In Person Meeting with MCO's: A meeting with IME leaders and the MCO's is scheduled to be held at the IME offices November 30, 2015 to discuss SIM and value based purchasing strategies to align our state across payers.



In Person Meeting with ACO's: Plans are underway at IIME to develop an In-person meeting with Medicaid ACO partners to discuss Value Based Purchasing arrangements and progress with the Iowa SIM vision as we move forward with Medicaid Modernization. This meeting is expected to take place early in 2016.

Monthly Claims Sharing Process: The process to share claims with ACO providers on a monthly basis kicked off in October of 2014. Once your ACO has successfully accepted a test file, notify 3M to receive the three year file. From that point, regular claim updates will be sent each time the 3M Treo Dashboard is updated.
