Dashboard Refreshed October 10, 2015: The Dashboard tool reflects claims paid through July 31, 2015.

Current Statistics:

- There are a total of 679,000 Medicaid members analyzed in the dashboard which include percentages of the following:
 - Healthy and Non Users **(66.25%)**
 - Pregnancy/Delivery **(1.70%)**
 - Significant Acute **(8.4%)**
 - Minor Chronic **(7.23%)**
 - Moderate Chronics **(9.56%)**
 - Dominant Chronics **(6.40%)** – *Just over 43,000 individuals*
 - Malignancies and Catastrophic **(.46%)**
- Current VIS score by ACO:
 - Broadlawns **(44.9%)**
 - IowaHealth+ **(52.6%)**
 - Mercy ACO, LLC **(63.5%)**
 - Unity Point Health Partners **(64.8%)**
 - University of Iowa Health Alliance **(55.2%)**
 - All other PCPs – **(42.8%)**

Total VIS scores showed improvement for all ACO's with this Dashboard Refresh! Great work!

Statewide Alert Notification (SWAN) System: Congratulations to Broadlawns Medical Center they were the first ACO to go “live” with the SWAN. Genesis and Unity Point are making significant progress toward “live” status. Please ensure that your IT Contact(s) have scheduled your ADT Connection meeting with Andi Bryan (andrea.bryan@idph.iowa.gov) from the Iowa Department of Public Health. She has a Readiness Assessment and Attachment G of the IHIN Participation Agreement that needs to be complete prior to establishing an ADT connection and before an ACO can start receiving real-time alerts. Alerts are targeted to begin in late October or early November 2015.

Monthly Claims Sharing Process: The process to share claims with ACO providers on a monthly basis kicked off in October of 2014. Once your ACO has successfully accepted a test file, notify 3M to receive the three year file. From that point, regular claim updates will be sent each time the 3M Treo Dashboard is updated. If your ACO is interested in receiving claims, please email Marni Bussell at mbussel@dhs.state.ia.us to start the Claims Sharing Process.

There have been minor updates to the claims data file layout in July of 2015. Please refer to the Document Library in the Dashboard homepage to retrieve the most up-to-date file layout specifications.
