

**Amendment to the Contract for Iowa Foundation for Medical Care
Iowa Medicaid Enterprise Medical Services Unit
Contract No. MED-04-034-A
Amendment No. 7**

This Seventh Amendment to Contract Number MED-04-034-A (“Contract”) between the Iowa Department of Human Services (Department) and the Iowa Foundation for Medical Care (IFMC - the “Contractor”), is effective November 1, 2009, and shall remain coterminous with the original Contract.

Section 1. Amendment to Contract. The Contract is amended and supplemented as follows:

Modify 6.1, (Performance Based contract) by modifying the valued listed for SFY 2010, detailed in new Attachment 7, cost proposal, to read as follows:

The price for the second one (1) year Renewal Option Year is:

SFY 2010 \$ 11,211,208 (an additional \$ 286,400 to be billed only as costs incurred)

Modify Contractor Responsibility 12 in Attachment 5, section 8.3.6 (Disease Management) that reads as follows:

12. Conduct tele-health disease management program for Medicaid members with diagnosis of congestive heart failure. Expand membership for SFY 2010 to 415 members.

Add Contractor Responsibility 10 in Attachment 5, section 8.4.6 (Enhanced Primary Care Case Management) that reads as follows:

10. Develop and implement a maternal health care management program to be operational January 1, 2010.

The Medicaid Maternity Care Management (MMCM) program will:

- Promote the successful delivery of healthy babies through education and ongoing prenatal support.
- Promote general prenatal wellness, care coordination with complications and adherence to care plans.

The nurse care managers will:

- Screen, assess, plan, implement, coordinate, monitor and evaluate options and services to meet the member’s health needs through communication and coordination of resources to promote quality cost-effective outcomes.
- Determine level of risk associated with the pregnancy and develop an individual care plan for the member.

Add Performance Standard 5 in Attachment 5, section 8.4.9 (Enhanced Primary Care Case Management) that reads as follows:

5. For the Medicaid Maternity Care Management (MMCM) program, demonstrate cost avoidance by measuring:

- Decrease rate of low weight births
- Increase in the number of prenatal care visits
- Increase the rate of postpartum care visits
- Increase dental care during pregnancy

Add Contractor Function 16 in Attachment 5, section 8.6.7 (Prior Authorization) that reads as follows:

16. Develop and implement a process for prior authorizations of high-tech imaging (such as MRI, MRA, CT, and PET) for radiology services. The process will require prior authorization of high tech imaging except in hospital and emergency room settings. The contractor will develop medical review process and procedures for high-tech imaging for the Department's approval, that will target variation in practice, promote cost-effective clinical decision making and increase the safety of Iowa Medicaid members. The program will be operational by March 1, 2010.

Section 2. Ratification. Except as expressly amended and supplemented herein, the Contract shall remain in full force and effect, and the parties hereby ratify and confirm the terms and conditions thereof.

Section 3. Authorization. Each party to this Amendment represents and warrants to the other that:

- 3.1 It has the right, power, and authority to enter into and perform its obligations under this Amendment.
- 3.2 It has taken all requisite actions (corporate, statutory, or otherwise) to approve execution, delivery and performance of this Amendment, and this Amendment constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation upon itself in accordance with its terms.

Section 4. Execution. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth above and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt, adequacy and legal sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties have entered into the above Amendment and have caused their duly authorized representatives to execute this Amendment.
