The Health Home Program gives extra help to Medicaid members living with chronic conditions.

- To make sure you get the care you need, a plan is developed by your Primary Care Provider.
- Your Health Home team will ask you about housing, transportation, family history and any barriers to care.
- While you are eligible for Medicaid, the Home Health team will be there to support you.

Help with chronic health care needs by coordinating care and providing you with extra services

What is the Iowa Medicaid Health Home Program?

Your Health Home is not a building or a place of residence. It's an approach to care that provides you with a team of professionals working together to meet all your health care needs. This is your chance to play a big role in your health care and gain healthier results related to chronic medical conditions.

What are the extra benefits of having a Health Home?

- During routine check-ups, more time will be spent planning for your health care needs.
- You and your Health Home team will have better communication. You will have access to your care team 24/7.
- Your Primary Care Provider will work with a medical team to manage all of your health care needs.
- Your medical records will be electronic giving your entire medical team access to all of your health records.

Who is eligible?

- Members who get full Medicaid benefits.
- Members who get full Medicaid benefits and who also have Medicare.

What are the conditions for eligibility?

Individuals who have two chronic conditions or one chronic condition and are at risk for a second chronic condition from the following list of qualifying conditions*:

- Hypertension
- Heart Disease
- Substance Abuse
- Mental Health
- Obesity
- Diabetes
- Asthma

* Your Primary Care Provider determines eligibility.

Members in the following programs are not eligible for the Health Home Program:

- IowaCare
- Qualified Medicare Beneficiary
- Special Low Income Medicare Beneficiary
- Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly
- Iowa Family Planning Network
- Health Maintenance Organization members
- Presumptive Eligibles**

** *Temporary Medicaid coverage for women who are pregnant or who need treatment for breast and cervical cancer and children under the age of 19 who need temporary medical coverage while their Medicaid application is being processed.*
