

## Criteria for Placement at the State Training School

Section 232.52(2)(e), Code of Iowa, 2013

### Option A.

- 1) Child is at least 12 years of age, and
- 2) The court finds the placement to be in the best interest of the child or necessary for the protection of the public, and
- 3) The child has been found to have committed an act which is a forcible felony, as defined in section 702.11, or a felony violation of section 124.401 or chapter 707

### Option B.

The court finds any three of the following conditions exist:

- 1) The child is at least 15 years of age and  
The court finds the placement to be in the best interests of the child or necessary to the protection of the public.
- 2) The child has committed an act which is a crime against a person and  
The crime would be an aggravated misdemeanor or a felony if the act were committed by an adult.
- 3) The child has previously been found to have committed a delinquent act.
- 4) The child has previously been placed in a treatment facility outside the child's home or in a supervised community treatment program established pursuant to section 232.191, subsection 4, as a result of a prior delinquency adjudication.
