

Fifteenth Amendment to the Contract

This Fifteenth Amendment to the Contract for Iowa Medicaid Enterprise Services (the "Contract") between the State of Iowa, Department of Human Services (the "Agency" or "DHS") and Telligen, Inc., (the "Contractor") is made pursuant to Section 22.5 of the Contract. This Amendment is effective as of July 1, 2014, and will remain coterminous with the Contract. The Amendment modifies, to the extent specified below, the terms and conditions of the Contract:

Section 1: Background

The purpose of this Amendment is to continue funding for ICD-10 work as outlined in Section 6.2.8, which was incorporated into the Contract through the Third Amendment.

Section 2: Amendment to Contract Language

The Contract is amended as follows:

Revision 1: Contract Section 7.1, Payment Terms and Compensation, is modified by adding the following text at the end of the section:



Notwithstanding the above, for services performed pursuant to section 6.2.8 of the RFP, the Contractor will be paid the following:
 For services performed on or after 7/1/14, the Contractor will be paid a fixed rate of \$86.50 per hour, with a maximum not to exceed amount of \$106,353.

Section 2: Ratification & Authorization

Except as expressly amended and supplemented herein, the Contract shall remain in full force and effect, and the parties hereby ratify and confirm the terms and conditions thereof. Each party to this Amendment represents and warrants to the other that it has the right, power, and authority to enter into and perform its obligations under this Amendment, and it has taken all requisite actions (corporate, statutory, or otherwise) to approve execution, delivery and performance of this Amendment, and this Amendment constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation upon itself in accordance with its terms.

Section 3: Execution

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth above and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt, adequacy and legal sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties have entered into the above Amendment and have caused their duly authorized representatives to execute this Amendment.
