18. Toy chest does not stay open or has a lid latch or no ventilation holes is used					
19. Changing tables are unsafe or unsanitary					
20. Indoor climbing equipment over 12 inches lacks appropriate fall surfacing					
21. Water temperature over 120 degrees or under 60 degrees					
22. Electrical outlets are not tamper resistant or do not have tamper-resistant covers (GFCI Outlets not used where needed)					
23. Electrical cords are dangling within reach of children or not used appropriately					
24. Chemicals or toxic materials are within reach of children or used when children are present					

25. Heavy equipment/furniture is not anchored					
26. Open pails or buckets of water are in child occupied areas					
27. Mini-blind or Venetian blind cords are looped, knotted or draped					
28. Strangulation hazards are present (drawstrings, ribbons, scarves, toy cords, etc)					
29. Choking hazards present in areas with children under 3 years of age (magnets, button batteries, etc)					
30. Basketball nets are recalled or unsafe					
31. Ride-on vehicles are recalled or unsafe					
32. Outdoor playground area lacks appropriate fall surfacing material &/or fall-surfacing material is not at appropriate depth &/or there is not an appropriate use-zone around elevated playground equipment					
33. Playground area has trip hazards (exposed footings, tree roots, etc)					
34. Playground equipment is in poor condition or needs repair					
35. Playground equipment or play area has sharp points or corners					
36. Playground equipment is missing caps or plugs					

37. Playground equipment has hazardous protrusions & projections					
38. Playground equipment has entrapment hazards					
39. Climbing equipment is not installed correctly or not anchored					
40. Trampoline is in use (both full & mini-size)					
41. A body of water is present in caregiving area and lacks the appropriate barrier fencing					
42. Wading pools are used					
43. Bicycle helmets are not used when appropriate or do not meet CPSC standards
