Jean Slaybaugh was appointed as the Chief Financial Officer of the Department of Human Services in October 2010. Ms. Slaybaugh is a finance and operations management professional with twenty-five years of broad industry experience. Her background includes extensive experience in strategic planning and business development. She has held key positions with large publicly traded federal contractors, has worked in the hospital and home health provider sectors, and has extensive experience in the health care management field.

Ms. Slaybaugh leads the fiscal management division and is responsible for planning, monitoring and accounting for an annual budget of more than \$5 billion. The fiscal management division is also responsible for payables, receipts and purchasing; service contract support; child support collections and disbursement services; and for corporate human resources for the agencies 5,000 employees. She is an active participant on several internal executive committees and is the department's representative on selected external boards and work groups. Ms. Slaybaugh is the agencies primary contact with the Department of Management and represents the agency in presentations to legislative staff and committees.
