



Integrated Health Home(IHH) Per Member Per Month (PMPM) Fee Schedule as of April 1, 2014:

Member's Tier	PMPM Rate
Tier 5 (Adult)	\$127.97
Tier 6 (Child)	\$127.59
Tier 7 (Adult with Intensive Care Management)	\$347.97
Tier 8 (Child with Intensive Care Management)	\$347.59
Tier 9 (Member Outreach Adults and Children – allowed for three months only)	\$102.40

When is it appropriate to receive a PMPM payment for IHH services?

The criteria required to receive a monthly PMPM payment is:

- A. The member meets the eligibility requirements as identified by the lead entity and documented in the member's electronic health record (EHR).
- B. The member has full Medicaid benefits at the time the PMPM payment is made.
- C. The member has enrolled with the IHH provider.
- D. The lead entity is in good standing with IME and is operating in adherence with all health home provider standards
- E. The minimum service required to merit a PMPM payment is that the IHH has performed member outreach activities (tier 9), or the person has received care management monitoring for treatment gaps defined as health home services in this state plan and health home services provided for the member have been documented (tier 5 -8).

The PMPM payment is a reflection of the added value provided to members receiving this level of care and is risk adjusted based on the level of acuity assigned to each patient based on the provider's overall health assessment using the PTAT guidelines published by the State.
