Intellectual Disability (ID) Waiver Renewal

Posted December 6, 2018

Pursuant to the authority of Iowa Code Section 249A.4, the Iowa Department of Human Services (DHS) intends to renew the Home and Community Based services (HCBS) Intellectual Disability (ID) Waiver effective July 1, 2019. This notice provides details about the ID Waiver renewal and serves to open the 30-day public comment period which closes on January 4, 2019.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) authorizes 1915(c) HCBS Waivers for a period of five years. The ID Waiver renewal application does not include any substantive changes to the currently approved waiver.
