Goals by 2018:

Improve Population Health

Iowa will improve the health of its population in at least four of the six SIM focus areas: Diabetes, Obstetrics, Healthcare-Associated Infection, Medication Safety, Obesity, Tobacco use.

Transform Health Care

Iowa will reduce the rates of preventable events (ED and Inpatient) for individuals in a VBP arrangement

Promote Sustainability

Iowa will increase the amount of providers participating in VBP and establish a decreased trend in TCOC

Conduct analytic evaluation of delivery system quality and key population health metrics

Conduct rapid cycle evaluation of outcomes data to stakeholders
