

STATE PLAN UNDER TITLE XIX OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT

STATE IOWASection 1924 Provisions

- A. Income and resource eligibility policies used to determine eligibility for institutionalized individuals who have spouses living in the community are consistent with §1924 of the Act.
- B. In the determination of resource eligibility the State resource standard for the community spouse is \$24,000.
- C. The definition of undue hardship for purposes of determining if institutionalized spouses receive Medicaid in spite of having excess countable resources is described below:

Exception based on estrangement. When it is established by a disinterested third party source that the institutionalized spouse is estranged from the community spouse, Medicaid eligibility will not be denied on the basis of resources when the applicant can demonstrate hardship.

The applicant can demonstrate hardship when the applicant is unable to obtain information about the community spouse's resources after exploring all legal means.

The applicant can also demonstrate hardship when resources attributed from the community spouse cause the applicant to be ineligible, but the applicant is unable to access these resources after exhausting legal means.
