

Admission Criteria
What is a mental health crisis?

- Trouble with mood or thought processes that causes problems with normal activities of daily living. This requires immediate treatment.
- Could pose a danger to themselves or others, but it is not imminent.
- Would benefit from short term psychiatric treatment, with 24 hour supervision and rehabilitate back into the community.



A Day at Turning Point

- Medication management
- Daily programming
- "My Wellness Plan"
- Service Connection
- Therapy
- Telemedicine psychiatric care

 - Feb 1st '16 – Dec 1st '19 = 323
 - 2019 – 80 served
 - 22 re-admitted in 2019
- Services Needed
- Diagnosis Served
- Substance Use Treatment
- 90 Day Follow-up
