“From Volume to Value”

Value Based Purchasing in Medicaid **May 2016**

The State Innovation Model (SIM) Partner Update is a monthly communication to share information supporting Iowa’s efforts to implement value-based purchasing (VBP) specifically within the Medicaid program, but aligned with broader, statewide SIM reforms.

Through the SIM, Iowa is engaged in preparing communities to address population needs by collaborating with payers, providers and public health entities. The SIM aligns payers in reform that focuses payment on value; equips providers with tools and data to excel under VBP; and integrates public health principles more directly into the healthcare delivery system. Together, these approaches underpin a robust, statewide transformation effort to achieve Iowa’s SIM vision: ***Transforming Healthcare to Improve the Health of Iowans.***

Guiding Principle – Updated


The Iowa Medicaid Enterprise (IME) supports the healthcare delivery system’s capability to drive quality outcomes under value based purchasing by setting aligned quality goals across managed care contracting and ensuring reliable, timely information is shared. The healthcare delivery system is responsible taking action on information through improved care coordination targeting and intervention processes. The IME and the healthcare delivery system are engaged in a partnership that is jointly accountable for improving the delivery of healthcare, advancing population health, and lowering the total cost of care in Iowa.

VIS Dashboard Refreshed May 17th, 2016: The Value Index Score (VIS) Dashboard reflecting delivery system quality now includes claims paid up through February 29th, 2016.

Current Population Health Category Statistics: There are a total of 719,976 Medicaid members analyzed in the dashboard. They fit into the following health status categories:

- Healthy and Non Users 68.76%
- Pregnancy/Delivery 1.58%
- Significant Acute 7.14%
- Minor Chronic 6.93%
- Moderate Chronic 9.00%
- Dominant Chronic 6.15%
- Malignancies and Catastrophic .44%

Current VIS Scores and Trends by Value-Based Purchasing Organizations (VBPO): The chart below is indicative of an entire years' worth of data. The IME would like to thank our valued partners for their ongoing progress in Transforming the Health Care of Iowans.



- * Number of qualifying VIS *members* attributed to a provider within a VBPO (“ACO”):166,153
- * Number of qualifying VIS *members* NOT attributed to a provider within a VBPO: 177,590
- * Number of *providers* associated with VBPO (with enough data to qualify for a score): 613
- * Number of *providers* NOT associated with a VBPO (with enough data to qualify for a score): 582

VIS Baselines have been sent: Provider baseline scores are set annually against past performance and act as delivery system quality targets used in value based purchasing arrangements. 2016 VIS baseline scores were sent in March; all VBPO partners should have received an Excel file for their individual providers. The chart below outlines the 2016 baseline at the VBPO (“ACO”) level for each group. In the past, baselines were used to determine bonus payments paid by the IME (under the

Wellness Plan). Now, these scores will be instrumental in measuring quality improvement performance of VBP agreements with Medicaid Managed Care Organizations (MCOs).

Collaborating with MCOs: The IME continues to collaborate with the MCOs on the use of the 3M Dashboard, including development of a view specific to MCO performance. As a part of our effort, we have focused on how the 3M Dashboard relates to VBP agreements with the provider community. Discussions have also begun with the MCOs surrounding the use of the Iowa Health Information Network (IHIN) and the Statewide Alert Notification System (SWAN). We are working to get all the MCOs connected and to receive the SWAN’s ADT alerts.

Statewide Alert Notification (SWAN) System is LIVE! Broadlawns, Unity Point, Iowa Health Plus, and the UIHA are LIVE and receiving care coordination alerts! Mercy is also in the final stages of going to a live status. During the month of April 21 hospital locations were connected and the SWAN system generated 2474 alerts. The total alerts for patients who had an event outside of their assigned ACO totaled 1189 alerts. These daily alerts are opportunities to enhance care coordination. Note: due to the success of the SWAN system, the weekly claims based Inpatient reports stored in the 3M dashboard are no longer needed and will cease.

NEW! SIM Website: The SIM website reflects the collaborative work between the IME, the Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH), and the Iowa Healthcare Collaborative (IHC). Community Care Coalition (C3): There are already six C3 Communities spanning twenty counties across Iowa already receiving funding and technical support through the SIM. Three of the C3s are *implementation* awards and three are *developmental* awards. Their project period began on March 7. the [operational plan](#)⁴ that is posted. There will be future C3 awards, with the goal of establishing a statewide capability. Efforts by communities that are in the process of organizing and maturing but not yet under grant will still be recognized and eligible to receive technical assistance to help develop their capabilities.

SIM Learning Collaborative: The next SIM Learning Collaborative will be July 12, 2016 at the Prairie Meadows Events and Conference Center. Registration will be on the [IHC website](#)⁵ and registration information will be made public closer to the event date. There will also be a Care Coordination Conference to be held on June 15, 2016

Monthly Claims Sharing Process: The process to share claims with VBPO providers on a monthly basis kicked off in October 2014. Regular claim updates will be sent each time the 3M Treo Dashboard is refreshed (approximately monthly). If your VBPO is interested in receiving claims, please email Tanya McAninch at tmcanin@dhs.state.ia.us to start the claims sharing process.
