

# **County Community Services Boone and Madison Counties FY 13 Management Plan/Annual Review**

County Community Services, (CCS), is the entity that manages mental health services for Boone and Madison Counties. CCS is made up of two units: The CPC/Administrative unit and the Case Management unit.

## **I. Progress Toward Goals and Objectives**

The CCS Board, staff, the advisory committees and work groups have identified the following guiding principles, goals and objectives for Boone and Madison Counties for FY 13:

### **Guiding Principles**

- All consumers of mental health, mental retardation, and developmental disability services in Boone and Madison Counties have a right to live, work, learn, and recreate to full independence and permanence in the community.
- All consumers have the right to full community integration, and access to normal community resources and supports, without discrimination or stigmatization.
- All consumers and their families have a right to full participation in planning for access to needed services and supports, and to exercise reasonable choice in services and providers of services within the context of available resources and legal limitations.
- All consumers and their families have a right to responsiveness to cultural and linguistic diversity and to accommodation from service providers to overcome physical or cultural barriers to needed services and supports within the context of available resources/reasonable costs.

## **Primary Goal**

- The primary goal for CCS this FY was to work on implementation of the MH redesign legislation. Boone and Madison Counties have entered into a 28 E agreement with 9 other Counties to form the Central Iowa Community Services Region. The region is working on a Regional Management Plan and the formation of an Advisory Board. A fiscal agent has been named and funds have been pooled.

## **II. Documentation of Stakeholder Involvement**

The Counties utilize the following methods for involving stakeholders.

**Madison County** has an Advisory Council made up of community members, parents of individuals receiving services and providers. This group meets quarterly. CCS provides financial and service data. The Council discusses current issues, provides feedback to CCS, helps identify service needs and assists with short and long range planning. The Council process is such that they can make recommendations to the Madison County Board of Supervisors. One of the primary accomplishments of the Advisory Council was to ensure that day services continued to be available in the County.

**Boone County** has an advisory committee that is made up of providers, service professional and consumers. Their purpose is to monitor and improve service quality, identify service needs and develop services to meet these needs. One of the primary accomplishments of this committee was to start up a county wide Mental Health Task force. This was done in response to three law enforcement shootings involving individuals with mental health issues.

The CPC and the Case Management Supervisor serve on the Decat. board and work with the Empowerment board and their coordinator.

The Case Management unit has an advisory board made up of community professionals, consumers and parents/guardians. Their function is to learn more about the delivery of services, evaluate the overall performance of the case management unit and provide feedback to CCS administrative staff.

### **III. Number, Type and Resolution of Appeals**

There were no appeals filed within the last review period.

### **IV. Quality Assurance Implementation, Findings and Impact on Plan**

As noted above, Boone and Madison Counties have entered into a 28E agreement to form a multi county Region. An advisory Board is being formed. Committees have also been formed to standardize the commitment process, rate setting process and look at Regional service needs. We are waiting for the rules to implement service outcome measures and monitoring.
